

親愛的弟兄姊妹, 主內平安:

轉瞬間, 2023 年即將過去。一年來, 我們實在經歷上主豐盛的恩典, 為此獻上感恩。謹此多謝你們一直多方支持 K-PACT Canada 的事工。慶幸有你們與我們在印尼跨文化宣教事奉上同工同行, 在禱告和經濟上不斷支持, K-PACT Canada 的事工可以按著上主的帶領漸趨前進, 履行上主交付我們為福音的使命。願一切尊貴、榮耀全歸上主, 就是那深愛世人、並呼召我們作祂僕人的基督。

感謝上主奇妙的帶領, 2023 年是 K-PACT Canada 推展事工一個重要的里程碑。感謝上主賜給我們有很同心事奉的團隊, 使我們服事主、充滿喜樂。數算主恩之際, 以下五點在此值得一提:

(1) 本年一月底 K-PACT Canada 獲加拿大稅務局 CRA 批核成為合法 "Registered Charity", 意味著在事工上進入一個新的階段。

(2) K-PACT Canada 今年內亦獲得更多本地華人教會認同, 不但給與機會在個別教會分享宣教事工, 更願意參與成為印尼宣教夥伴, 在禱告和經濟上一同承擔 K-PACT Canada 事工的需要。

(3) 自新冠疫情放緩至今, 過去 14 個月內 K-PACT Canada 主辦三次印尼短宣行程 (每次為期 15 至 30 天不等), 每次行程皆為各短宣隊員帶來非常深刻的印象, 大大提昇各人對印尼宣教的抱負。

(4) K-PACT Canada 除了在西加里曼丹有三個早已結合的福音夥伴之外, 今年漸漸增添了在東爪哇 Malang 的 HOPE MINISTRY。HOPE MINISTRY 是 K-PACT Canada 短宣隊在 2022 年 11 月首次前往 Malang 時相識的, 該事工的同工們自本年初固定參加 K-PACT Canada 每月網上祈禱會, 彼此建立美好關係, 互相關懷代禱; 最近在 10 月 K-PACT Canada 短宣隊慶幸有機會再次前往 Malang 與 HOPE MINISTRY 同工們一起事奉, 使我們對印尼跨文化宣教有更進一步的體會。

(5) 藉著本年 K-PACT Canada 印尼短宣行程, 有機會探訪西加里曼丹和東爪哇不同的村落, 上主讓我們更深入看見當地人逼切的需要和現今的福音契機, 特別在西加里曼丹較落後地區, 兒童教育固然之是最為缺乏, 而醫療保健的需要亦不相伯仲, 亦是目前在印尼一個很有效傳福音的媒介。

「醫療中心」的意念自去年年底油然而生, 起初有點天方夜譚之感, 祇是一直放在禱告中。一年來上主很奇妙地為此「醫療中心」構想開路, 雖然離事成尚遠, 未見端倪, 卻需要大家為此切切禱告, 尋求上主的引領, 幫助我們憑信心踏足前路, 倚靠主、行步見步。

Dear supporters : Warmest greetings from K-PACT Canada! **HAPPY NEW YEAR 2024!**

As we approach the end of the year 2023, we give thanks to our gracious God for His guidance and timely provision throughout the year. We would like to say THANK YOU in appreciation of your faithful support in the cross-cultural ministry of K-PACT Canada through prayers and generous giving. We are so grateful for your partnership in ministry, which has allowed us to carry on the missionary work that God has commissioned to us in Indonesia for His glory according to His agenda. May the name of Christ be magnified on high, all honor and glory to the Lord God who so loved people of all nations and has graciously called us to be His servants for His purposes.

The year 2023 was indeed a blessed year and significant milestone for K-PACT Canada. Thank the Lord for the joy in serving God with one accord in our ministry team. As we count our blessings, the following five items are worth highlighting :

(1) K-PACT Canada was approved by CRA to be a “Registered Charity” in January this year, implying the beginning of a new page for our Indonesia cross-cultural ministry endeavor.

(2) More local churches have shown their interest and endorsement in K-PACT Canada with prayers and financial support in partnership for Indonesia ministry, granting us mission sharing opportunities at local churches and fellowship groups.

(3) With the easing of pandemic, K-PACT Canada was able to organize a total of three Short-term mission trips to Indonesia (varying between 15-30 days) in the past 14 months. Each of these STM trips was a striking experience for all who participated, giving them a greater understanding and a missionary heart for the Unreached people in Indonesia.

(4) Besides our three primordial ministry partners in West Kalimantan, we also have HOPE MINISTRY in Malang, East Java joining us as ministry partner since the beginning of this year. We became acquainted with the Malang HOPE MINISTRY team when we first went to Malang during our STM trip in November 2022. We are very glad that the ministry team members started to join us regularly in our CONNECT IN CHRIST monthly Prayer Meeting on ZOOM, supporting each other in prayers and encouragement. We were so grateful to be in Malang again on our October 2023 STM trip recently, allowing us to gain a better understanding on Indonesia cross-cultural ministry.

(5) God has helped us to gradually gain a deeper understanding in the urgent needs of Indonesia and possible ministry opportunities among the local people, especially those living in the rural areas, through visitation in various villages both in West Kalimantan and East Java during our STM trips this year. While the lack of proper education for children is still the most compelling, God has led us to see that insufficient medical health is also a great issue in Indonesia. Hence, the initiative of a “Health Clinic” in West Kalimantan arose in our thoughts and prayers, which seemed to be unthinkable at first. Without much ambitious planning on our part, God has miraculously opened doors for us towards this intent throughout this year. Although currently we are still in a primitive stage of this enormous ministry project, we continue to wait upon the Lord for His guidance and provision. Let us pray earnestly together for this need, asking God to lead us, strengthening us to take proper steps in faith according to His will, trusting Him as we move forward courageously in this endeavor.

Please take note in this Newsletter, the brief sharing from each of our STM team members of what they find most impressive during their recent (October 2023) STM experience in Indonesia. We have also included some information on our next Indonesia STM trip, coming up in April 1-15, 2024. Your prayers are much needed and appreciated.

May the richest blessings of God be upon you in the New Year 2024, enabling you to grow further spiritually in the love of the Lord, serving Him diligently with grace upon grace, strength upon strength.

K-PACT Canada October 10th – 23rd, 2023 Short-term Mission Trip

Question : What is the most impressive experience you had on this STM trip?

Sharing from our STM team members 短宣隊員個別分享行程最深刻的感受 :

Edgar Ng : First time praying together with Muslims was a very striking experience. So amazing in seeing how God's kingdom is expanded to the unreached people in Indonesia. I'm so excited and thankful for the youths and children in Indonesia in their dedication to God.

Kary Tsui : What impressed me the most in this Indonesia STM experience:

- * The innocent smiles on the faces of children, in the cities and villages
- * The passion and faithful commitment of the young leaders
- * The vision and missional mind of the local church pastors

My two weeks in Indonesia was like a walking Bible. I witnessed how people lived out biblical truth. May God bless Indonesia.

Judith Yan : Things that I find most impressive during this STM trip:

- Sacrifice and commitment to God's calling; they don't take lightly God's saving grace by pouring out their lives for Him.
- How missional they all are
- How they really live out walking by faith and not by sight
- The children's spiritual maturity at such a young age
- Their heart for the unreached people

Pastor Sam Chan : My thoughts on this past mission trip: "I am so thankful that each mission trip I take has brought me deeper in appreciating the desperate needs of the people wherever we go. They are like sheep without a shepherd. Yet, at the same time I also see God is at work opening the door to reaching these people with the gospel of Jesus Christ. I am encouraged that quite a lot of local 'missionaries' are hard at work as Jesus' ambassadors among the unreached people. But as Jesus says in Matthew 9:27, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few." I pray that more Christians, be they local or overseas, are heeding Jesus, the Lord of the Harvest's calling to go into the harvest field."

Pastor Anthony Yeung : This was my 7th time in Indonesia for short-term mission; it was probably the most fruitful Indonesia mission trip I've ever had. Not only that we were able to visit various places that we had never been to, but we were also able to meet and share with local people from different cultural and religious background. I am very encouraged to see how God is guiding us little by little, and strengthening us in gradually moving on boldly for His Kingdom, even though we are so limited. What's most striking to me on this trip : while I was having a conversation with a local Christian in Pontianak, this was what he said to me in Chinese, “你知道在印尼甚麼最平宜? 在印尼人命最平宜! (Did you know what is the cheapest in Indonesia? Human lives are the cheapest!)” This strongly reminisces how God first called me to cross-cultural ministry in Indonesia through John 3:16 “For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son...”
